### **PURPOSE**

This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged services; either in residential, home or community based environments. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery.

Workers may be required to demonstrate leadership and have limited responsibility for the organisation and the quantity and quality of outputs of others within limited parameters.

#### **DURATION**

This course will be delivered over 60 weeks as following:

40 Weeks Classroom Delivery: Practical Placement: 8 Weeks Holidays: 12 Weeks

# TRAINING ARRANGEMENTS

Class sessions are planned to ensure that student have a mixture of practical and theoretical components and those classes cater for a wide variety of learning styles. Additionally, workplace practices and environments will be regularly simulated and used to conduct skills based assessments in accordance with unit requirements.

# **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Whilst there are no entry requirements stipulated in the training package, WMIT requires its participants to meet the following criteria:

- 18 years or older at commencement of course.
- IELTS (Academic) band score of 5.5 or
- Completion Australian Year 11 or equivalent.

#### **PLACEMENT ARRANGEMENTS**

Students are required to complete a minimum 120 hours of work placement in a regulated Aged Care Centre for successful completion of the course. Work Placement is an important component of the qualification that provide students with the opportunity to apply skills and knowledge in an aged care setting.
